

Preparatory course options

Main Program Full-time program

One of the best programs to study in the preparatory year, as it contains a sufficient period of time that allows the student to acquire the greatest amount of scientific knowledge and provides them with sufficient time to master the Russian language. The study session is conducted on a daily basis inside the university campus with a group of the best teachers.

The advantages of the program:

- enough time to study the Russian language
- possibility of applying to Russian universities after the end of the program.
- possibilities of adapting to life in Russia.

Duration

- October to July
- November to July

Subjects:

- Russian language
- Russian literature
- Medical specialty (Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science)
- Engineering specialty (Physics, Mathematics, Computer Science)

TUTION FEES:

- 90,000 Russian rubles (includes textbooks)

Additional expenses

- Health insurance 5500 Russian rubles (paid annually)
- Administrative expenses 1500 (paid only once)
- University accommodation (paid monthly)

Additional program

Remote full-time program (Online from the country of residence)

The program provides the opportunity for those who are unable to leave their countries (regardless of their reasons) to study the preparatory year from their home countries, while providing them with daily online lectures with a group and some individual lectures.

The advantages of the program:

- opportunity to study the preparatory year remotely
- obtaining a certificate that allows the student to apply to Russian public universities.

Not being present in Russia might be considered as an issue for the lack of an opportunity to mingle with the Russian society but the university works together with the students to solve this issue.

Duration

- October to July
- November to July

Subjects:

- Russian language
- Russian literature
- Medical specialty (Chemistry - Biology - Computer Science)
- Engineering specialty (Physics, Mathematics, Computer Science)

TUTION FEES:

- 80,000 Russian rubles

(includes textbooks in PDF)
No additional expenses required due to the fact that the student is not in Russia

Additional program

Half-year program to study the Russian language

A program dedicated to studying the only Russian language without any scientific subjects for a period of 6 months for those who would like to get acquainted with the Russian language and reach an intermediate level that allows them to speak Russian.

The advantages of the program:

- . Reaching an intermediate level in the Russian language
- . The program is suitable for students, employees or anyone who wishes to study the Russian language.

The certificate given after the completion of the program is a certificate that indicates the completion of Level A2 of the Russian language.

Duration

- February to July

Subjects:

- Russian language
- Russian literature

TUTION FEES:

- 45,000 Russian rubles (includes textbooks)

Additional expenses

- Health insurance 5500 Russian rubles (paid annually)
- Administrative expenses 1500 (paid only once)
- University accommodation (paid monthly)

Enrollment Requirements Invitation letter

1. In order to apply for an invitation letter an international prospective student should send a filled in application form, a scanned copy of their passport (a front page with a photo and information on the date of the issue and the date of expiry), a scanned copy of the last diploma for preliminary assessment.
2. Upon receiving a reply informing that an invitation letter is processed it is necessary to legalize diploma (nostrification/apostilization) according to established procedure.
3. Upon receiving an invitation letter an applicant should turn to an Embassy of the Russian Federation for visa procedure.
4. Required documents:
 - passport and its copy
 - original diploma and its verified copy (the document should be legalized if necessary)
 - migration card and its copy;
 - medical certificate (HIV, blood microrecipitation reaction MP, chest X-ray);
 - 6 '3/4' matte photos.

Learning agreement

Following documents are needed for learning agreement:

- passport and its copy;
- original educational certificate and its attested copy (documents are to be legalized if needed);
- medical certificate (HIV, blood microprecipitation reaction, chest X- ray);
- a letter of acceptance;
- assignment application.

Migration registration

According to the current migration legislation, to the Russian Federation every foreign citizen or person out of citizenship is obliged to register within three days upon arrival at the place of residence. To do so, you should come to a preparatory department.

For arrival registration, you should have:

- passport and its copy;
- migration card and its copy;
- copy of educational contract.
